KARLA CONWAY

<u>Karla Conway</u> is a multi award-winning director, dramaturg and theatre maker. She trained at the University of Missouri-Columbia, USA and is a Directing graduate of the National Institute of Dramatic Art (NIDA). Karla has directed over 30 productions, driven two international collaborations; had two interstate and international tours and as Artistic Director of CYT, commissioned 9 new Australian plays. She has also been the creator of numerous innovative works as a theatre maker, including two site-specific works for the National Library and the National Gallery of Australia. As

dramaturg, Karla has worked across theatre, circus and dance — including the development of new American plays at the Missouri New Play Workshop; on new Australian works by multi-award winning playwrights Angela Betzien, Lachlan Philpott (*Run Rihanna! Run!* Published by Currency Press), Jessica Bellamy and Michele Lee; has been a dramaturg for The Street's Hive Program and has been resident dramaturg for Warehouse Circus since 2014. Karla has a vested interest in supporting the growth of the ACT Arts industry nationally and internationally. She represented Australia at the 2011 ASSITEJ International Directors Seminar (Germany); was Executive Producer of the National Theatre Summit for Young & Emerging Artists; has been on multiple peer assessment panels for the Australia Council and artsACT; and is currently co-Chair of the ACT Theatre Network. Karla was Artistic Director/CEO of Canberra Youth Theatre from 2010-2015 and has recently joined the staff at Warehouse Circus

ROBIN DAVIDSON

Robin Davidson is an actor, clown, director, teacher and writer. He is a graduate of Charles Sturt University in Theatre/Media. He specialises in devised theatre, Commedia dell'Arte, clown, playback theatre and Theatre of the Oppressed. He is artistic director of Rebus Theatre, a mixed ability theatre using interactive theatre for workplace training; was five years as founding artistic director of Hidden Corners Theatre, a company for young carers (young people who have a family member with a disability); fifteen years as a founding member of Canberra Playback Theatre; has directed five projects with the Mental Health Foundation ACT; and was a founding member of Full Tilt Performance Troupe, a company performing contemporary Commedia dell'Arte, traditional clown and roaming entertainment. He has taught in East Timor, Indonesia, Thailand and Sri Lanka. He was co-awarded the 2005 Media Entertainment and Arts Alliance ACT Green Room Award for services to community theatre.
