Please note, the nature of working for a theatre company and this position requires a degree of flexibility, and will include a mix of days, evenings, and weekends. Manual handling and working at heights is an inherent physical requirement of this role.

Duties

- Building maintenance: contribute to core infrastructure and facilities being well maintained.
- Equipment maintenance: contribute to ensuring all equipment owned by The Street is consistently in good working order, maintained and stored effectively, assist monitor consumables stock levels and equipment inventory.
- Production Support – Lighting, Sound and AV operation, Mechanist and Stage Management work; bump-in and bump-out venue work.
