## Adele Chynoweth

Director Adele Chynoweth is a theatre director, curator and researcher. Adele trained as a theatre director at the Flinders University Drama Centre and also has a PhD in contemporary Australian drama. Her directing credits include State Theatre SA, Vitalstatistix - National Women's Theatre, the 3rd International Women's Playwrights Conference and the Adelaide College of the Arts. Adele has also directed new work as part of The Street's Hive and First Seen programmes. Adele is a Visitor within the Centre for Heritage and Museum Studies at the ANU where, in 2012, she received a Vice-Chancellor's Award. Adele has curated exhibitions for the National Museum of Australia, the Bob Hawke Prime Ministerial Centre at the University of South Australia and as part of the official celebrations for the Centenary of Federation. Adele is also an international consultant for Welfare Stories: from the Edge of Society, a social history and justice project undertaken in Denmark.

# Emma Strapps Movement Director/Choreographer

Emma Strapps has been an independent choreographer and performer for twenty years and shiatsu practitioner for fourteen years. Since 2002 Emma has focused on her movement practice integrating dance, shiatsu and Traditional Chinese Medicine theory. She has created a thread of unique solo performances and performance installations. Most recently, Emma was movement designer at The Street for Constellations.

She has performed, choreographed and taught in Australia and internationally, in Japan, Europe and the UK. Emma is a founding member of Movement Research Forum, Melbourne.

Sound Designer Shoeb Ahmad has a rich and extensive background in Australian music over the last decade. A singer/composer and improviser, Shoeb performs both solo or as a member in a number of groups including Agency, Spartak and Tangents.

Combining both acoustic and electronic approaches to musicmaking, Shoeb has released a diverse range of original music - including the critically acclaimed Watch/Illuminate on English label Mystery Plays Records - while also collaborating with numerous directors and choreographers to provide sound design and soundtrack material for live theatre and dance works. In concert, Shoeb has performed throughout Australia, Japan, New Zealand, the UK and the SE Asian region.

Lighting Designer After graduating from Western Australian Academy of Performing Arts (Lighting), Linda worked between Perth and Canberra for companies such as Yirra Yaakin, Black Swan, Canberra Youth Theatre, Jigsaw Theatre Company, The Australian Choreographic Centre, Shortis and Simpson, Women on a Shoestring and the National Folk Festival.

After working at the Brisbane Convention and Exhibition Centre as Head of Lighting and Bunbury Regional Entertainment Centre as Technical Manager, Linda returned to Canberra and the role of Production and Operations Manager at The Street Theatre. Lighting designs for The Street include: The Faithful Servant, Cold Light, 7 Great Inventions, and The Iliad Out Loud.



I became impressed very quickly at the vast and rich array of verse composed here. I shared this observation with Caroline Stacey, The Street's Artistic Director/CEO and my idea to devise a poetry anthology of Canberra verse - a theatrical work embodied by professional actors as a complement to the conventional genre of poetry readings. In 2016, The Street funded me to create a performance text of poetry. I spent weeks in the National Library of Australia. It wasn't unusual for me to read 400 poems a day! I also attended poetry events and readings. The final script comprises diverse work both previously noted as well as unpublished and it elaborates on the motifs that I identified in A.D. Hope's poem *Under Sedation*.

Under Sedation: Canberra Verse Remixed is more than a celebration of the inspired work that local writers determinism applied, perhaps too performance, dream together.
